Hello County family,

As we pass the six-month mark in the fight against COVID-19 I want to thank you for your continued hard work and dedication and the support you provide to the citizens of Orange County. Orange County continues to make progress in this fight, and as has been the case since March, employees and the public continue to adjust to the ever changing circumstances brought on by the pandemic.

Attached is the 10th update to the COVID-19 FAQs for employees. Updates to the FAQs reflect changes to definitions in the Federal Families First Coronavirus Response Act and the application of several new State laws including AB 1867 (see attachment) and SB 1159 related to paid sick time and Workers' Compensation claims. Additionally updated information is included regarding the September 8, 2020 changes to the Orange County Public Health Order which now requires healthcare providers and emergency responders to obtain the seasonal flu vaccine and highly recommends that all County residents obtain the vaccination. All employees, are Strongly Encouraged to take advantage of the on-site flu shot clinics or the free flu shots through their County medical benefit plans. Employees may use up to one hour of County time to obtain a flu vaccine if scheduled during normally scheduled work hours. Employees are expected to coordinate with their direct supervisor in advance of your appointment.
