Making Enough Room for Love!

Double the number of ceremony rooms will be available at the Clerk-Recorder Department's three wedding offices in Orange County to accommodate couples wishing to marry on Valentine's Day.

Four rooms will be available at the Old County Courthouse, 211 W. Santa Ana Blvd, in Santa Ana. Two ceremony rooms each will be available at our branch offices: at the Laguna Hills Civic Center, 24031 El Toro Road, Suite 150, and in historic downtown Fullerton at 201 N. Harbor Blvd. The branch offices also offer free parking.

Couples must first obtain a marriage license and are advised to make an appointment for a civil wedding ceremony because of the day's popularity for weddings. Call for appointments at **(714) 834-2588** or visit our website at www.ocrecorder.com and use the online appointment system.

Clerk-Recorder Tom Daly makes special accommodations annually for Valentine's Day, even opening offices when the day falls on a weekend. "My staff pulls out all the stops every year to make sure our happy couples have a truly special experience," Daly said.

Valentine's Day typically sees four times the volume of marriage ceremonies compared to an average day. (For palindrome aficionados, this year's date has additional significance because it reads the same forward or backward: 21412.)

The Orange County Clerk-Recorder provides a variety of public services, including recording documents related to real property transactions, maintaining and issuing copies of birth, death and marriage certificates, issuing marriage licenses and performing civil wedding ceremonies. The department also files Fictitious Business Names, Notary Public oaths and bonds, and processes passport applications. The department oversees the Orange County Archives, a center for materials, research and education, preserving Orange County history for the public.
