The Orange County Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has reviewed the Registration Permit Application per Title 14 California Code of Regulations (CCR), § 18104.2 for the Rio Santiago facility. The LEA determined that the application was complete and correct and issued a new Registration Permit.

Description of New Permit: Rio Santiago is an Inert Debris Type A Disposal Facility where only Type A inert debris is disposed to land. Type A inert debris includes but is not limited to concrete (including fiberglass or steel reinforcing bar embedded in the concrete), fully cured asphalt, crushed glass, fiberglass, asphalt or fiberglass roofing shingles, brick, slag, ceramics, plaster, clay and clay products.

LEA Conformation Finding per §18104.1: The LEA finds that the facility is consistent with all CEQA documents and with all state minimum standards.
