

## Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarm Self-Certification

The state of California requires that smoke and carbon monoxide alarms must be installed in all residential buildings.

California Residential Code (CRC) Section R314.1 and R315.2 states in part that existing dwellings be "retrofitted with smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms. CRC Section R314.3, CRC R315.3 defines required locations.

***Both boxes below must be checked:***

- Carbon Monoxide Alarm: Installed outside of each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of bedrooms and each level of the dwelling.
- Smoke Alarms: Installed in each room used for sleeping purposes, in each hallway outside of the sleeping rooms, and on each level of the dwelling unit.

Retrofitted detectors may be battery operated for buildings where no alternations are performed on the interior. Multiple-purpose alarms (carbon monoxide and smoke alarms) shall comply with all applicable standards and must be approved by the State Fire Marshall. The devices must be installed per manufacturer's specifications.
